

Stars Come Out For American National Finals

American National finals for all 3-year-old divisions, 2-year-old pacers and older male horses are on tap Saturday night at Balmoral Park. Arguably the star of the show is Chapter Seven, a top candidate for 2012 Horse of the Year, who will

be making his final career start in the \$180,000 race for older male trotters.

Chapter Seven comes into the race with 19 wins in 27 career starts, including a 9-7-2-0 resume in 2012. The 4-year-old son of Windsong's Legacy rides a three-race win streak into Chicago, including his parked-the-mile win in the \$600,000 Breeders Crown final Oct. 27 at Woodbine Racetrack. Tim Tetrick will

drive the 3-5 morning-line favorite from post five.

Per the conditions, purses are split as follows: "22 percent to second; 11 percent to third; seven percent to fourth; four percent to fifth; two percent for all other starters; and the remainder to the race winner."

With a field of six in the Am-Nat Older Horse Trot, the winner's share is \$97,200, meaning a victory by Chapter Seven would vault the Linda Toscano trainee past the \$1-million mark in seasonal earnings, and bring his career total to just shy of \$2 million. The world champion Chapter Seven is owned by Richard Gutnick, Jerry and Theresa Silva and Southwind Stable.

Toscano will also be sending out Market Share, the current front-runner for 3-Year-Old Colt Trotter of the Year honors, in the \$235,000 American National. The Hambletonian champ and Canadian Trotting Classic winner brings a 2012 slate of 18-8-5-3 into the Am-Nat, with the possible winner's share of \$115,150 bringing his career earnings to just \$10,000 shy of \$2 million. The son of Revenue is owned by Gutnick, TLP Stable and Bill Augustine. Tetrick also gets the call here, leaving from post five with the 8-5 choice.

Foiled Again, the richest pacer of all-time with \$4,621,468 in earnings, will have his work cut out for him in the \$182,000 Am-Nat for older horses, leaving from the outside post nine with driver Yannick Gingras.

The 8-year-old Dragon Again gelding is just one of three Ron Burke-trained entries, joining Foreclosure N and An-

nieswesterncard, the second straight week the trio have lined up together. Foiled Again won the \$200,000 Indiana Pacing Derby Nov. 3 at Indiana Downs in 1:49.1, with Foreclosure N and Annieswesterncard finishing third and fifth, respectively.

“Foiled’ has been outstanding. Just unbelievable,” said Burke, who also shares ownership with Weaver Bruscelli LLC and JJK Stables. “He was so good the other day (in the Indiana Pacing Derby). The track was off and he just plowed through it.”

The even-money favorite in the \$145,000 American National for 3-year-old filly pacers is American Jewel, who went over the \$1-million mark in seasonal earnings with her win in the \$500,000 Breeders Crown final. The Jimmy Takter trainee starts from post five with Tetrick driving as she looks to win her ninth of the year in 16 starts.

Another heavy favorite is Maven in the \$130,000 Am-Nat for 3-year-old filly trotters. Listed at 6-5, she is also coming off a win in the \$500,000 Breeders Crown final. Starting from post five with Gingras driving, Maven takes on six as she looks for her eighth win of the year.

The richest pot of the night is the \$260,000 American National for 3-year-old colt pacers, with an evenly-matched field of 10 going postward. The speedy Hurrikane Kingcole is a lukewarm 7-2 morning-line favorite from post one with Dan Dube driving. Cane Pace winner DynamicYouth is second choice, followed by EZ Noah, a winner on the Pennsylvania Sires Stakes circuit who comes off a victory in the Monument Circle consolation at Indiana Downs.

Bolt The Duer Looks To Rebound In Messenger

Following a pair of sub-par efforts during the Grand Circuit stand at The Red Mile, All Star Racing's top 3-year-old colt pacer Bolt The Duer has bounced back nicely, romping to an easy qualifying victory at Indiana Downs and most recently, a score in preferred company Oct. 29 at The Meadows.

The turnaround comes after tests run at Rood & Riddle Equine Clinic in Lexington revealed small traces of blood in

Bolt The Duer's lungs. As a result, trainer Pete Foley placed the son of Ponder on Lasix, which has led to the quick reversal of fortunes. Bolt The Duer will now have a chance to restore some of the luster lost when he takes on seven rivals in Saturday night's \$415,820 Messenger at Yonkers Raceway. With \$828,153 in career earnings, a win would bring his total bankroll past the \$1-million

mark. Mark MacDonald will drive from post five.

Following a 1:47.4f world-record victory in the Adios final at The Meadows and then a sweep of the three-week Ken-

tucky Sires Stakes at The Red Mile, Bolt The Duer looked every bit the part of a serious contender for divisional honors. But a second-place finish in his Little Brown Jug elimination Sept. 20 at Delaware, Ohio, left Foley scratching his head as the colt seemed to fold after leading through soft middle fractions.

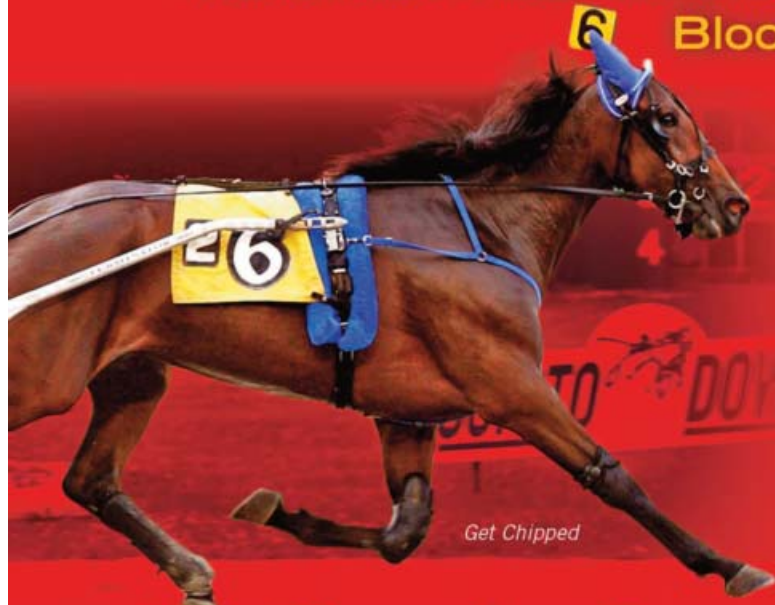
Foley had announced prior to the Jug that win or lose in the elims, he would scratch Bolt The Duer from the second heat. Bolt The Duer then returned to The Red Mile for the Bluegrass and Tattersalls, but the colt finished sixth and 12th, respectively.

“When you say he had that second quarter in 30 seconds in the Jug and lost, now we know why,” said Foley. “He probably could have won if had been 100 percent or on Lasix. But that’s racing.”

The first diagnosis was a throat inflammation but subsequent testing revealed the blood in his lungs. As a result, BoltThe Duer missed the Breeders Crown. Instead, just 10 days after the Tattersalls and the same day of the draw for the Breeders Crown elims, BoltThe Duer romped to a 14-length, 1:54.3 win in a qualifier at Indiana Downs, pacing his back half in :54 and final quarter in :26 for driver Peter Wrenn.

That win was followed up by his 1:52.3 score on a “sloppy” track at The Meadows, pacing his final half in :53.3 after closing from fifth for driver Mike Wilder.

“I wanted to race him from behind in that race, I didn’t even care if he got beat,” said Foley. “I had to get him ready for the Messenger, and with so much money on the line I didn’t want to race him too hard. He showed how good he is, coming home in :26.1, last half in :53.3.”

After racing BoltThe Duer on the front end for several weeks, Foley decided it was time to reverse strategy.

“He’s been smoked out of there so much I wanted to race him from behind,” he said. “I wanted to teach him to come off the gate.”

“Peter (Wrenn) said he was just perfect and when Wilder got off the horse he said he’s sat behind a lot of horses but he never sat behind a horse like that.”

Foley said he also has BoltThe Duer receiving regular treatments in a hyperbaric chamber. He said the colt will finish up his sophomore season with starts in the Matron at Dover Downs and Cleveland Classic at Northfield Park. Then both horse and trainer will get a well-deserved vacation.

“I’m leaving the day after Christmas with my wife to go to Australia for a couple weeks,” said Foley, a Down Under native who moved to the United States 40 years ago and now calls Kentucky home. “I haven’t been there in three years and my wife Lynne hasn’t been in 22 years since 1990.”

No Babying Googoo Gaagaa From Post 9 In Matron Elim

Number nine, number nine, number nine, number nine. No, not the song lyrics made famous by The Beatles, but the number of horses scheduled to start in a trio of Matron eliminations on Sunday night at Dover Downs.

Three fields of nine will line up behind the gate in Matron elims for 3-year-old colt trotters, 3-year-old filly trotters and 3-year-old filly pacers, with only the last-place finisher in each not advancing to the finals on Sunday, Nov. 18. Also on the card are four Matron previews for the other divisions as well as a Progress Pace preview contest for the seven entries.

Callahan last drove Googoo Gaagaa in his 1:52.1 win in the \$500,000 Colonial Trot Aug. 19 at Harrah’s Philadelphia, besting Hambletonian winner Market Share by a neck. That race was Googoo Gaagaa’s last start before getting a two-month break until the Sires Stakes.

“He just cruised around there in 1:54 in his last start and Morand said he could have gone a lot more,” said Callahan, who also was in the sulky behind Googoo Gaagaa when he

Owned and trained by Richard Hans, Googoo Gaagaa comes into the race off a 28 1/2-length romp in 1:54.1 in the \$32,000 Maryland Sires Stakes final Oct. 27 at Rosecroft Raceway.

Jim Morand drove Googoo Gaagaa in the Sires Stakes final as well as the elim the week before (a 23-length coaster in 1:58.1) while regular driver Corey Callahan was committed to drive several horses in the Breeders Crown elims and finals at Woodbine. Callahan will be

won the \$500,000 Earl Beal Jr. Memorial in June at Harrah’s Philadelphia in a world-record 1:50.4f. “They just wanted to go a nice, easy mile with him, and it’s crazy that a :54 mile is just a little stroll for him.”

Callahan said leaving from the trailing position in the Matron could pose some early problems but he believes Googoo Gaagaa has the talent to overcome things.

“I think he’s the best horse in there; I just have to get into a striking spot,” said Callahan. “He likes to mow ‘em down from back too, so we’ll just see where he lands. I wish the horses toward the inside had a little bit more speed because it looks like I might get away seventh or sixth at best.

“Sure, I’d rather have his nose on the gate, but I won’t have to worry about that next week since there will only be eight in there.”

Callahan noted that the Matron elims and—hopefully—final will be Googoo Gaagaa’s final starts of the year as the son of pacing stallion Cam’s Rocket looks to add to his seasonal bankroll of \$620,955.

“This is it for the year and then he’ll try the big boys next year. Good to hear that Chapter Seven won’t be there,” Callahan concluded with a laugh.

Also in the field are Kentucky Futurity winner My MVP, who will line up in post one in front of Googoo Gaagaa. My MVP is one of three Tony Alagna trainees in the race, joining Mr. Chicago and Modern Family. Trainer Jimmy Takter also has a trio of starters, including recent Breeders Crown runner-up Little Brown Fox, Hambletonian runner-up Guccio, and 2011 Breeders Crown champion Uncle Peter.

Seven 3 year olds will line up behind the gate in the Progress Pace preview Sunday night at Dover Downs, with the left side of the starting gate heavily slanted with three millionaires in the inside posts. Starting respectively from posts one, two and three are Tattersalls champ **Sweet Lou**, North America Cup winner **Thinking Out Loud**, and Breeders Crown victor **Heston Blue Chip**. The Progress Pace final is scheduled for Sunday, Nov. 18.

Breeders Crown 2-Year-Old Filly Pace winner **Somwherovrainbow** is also in action Sunday at Dover as she takes on a field of six in a Matron preview. The George Teague trainee is in search of her fifth straight victory. Also in that field is Pennsylvania Sires Stakes champion **Handsoffmycupcake**.

Time To Kill and **Royal Assets**, second and fourth, respectively, in the recent Breeders Crown 2-Year-Old Filly Trot at Woodbine, are two of five starters in a Matron preview. World champion **Dontyouforgetit** hopes to rebound off a break in the Breeders Crown 2-Year-Old Colt Trot as he takes on five in a Matron preview.

The Matron for 2-year-old colt pacers was originally a nine-horse elim but an early scratch left a field of eight and the contest changed to a preview as all will return for the final. That field includes Bluegrass division winner **Twilight Bonfire** and Elevation winner **Dedi's Dragon**.

World champion **Shelliscape** is the 6-5 favorite in the Matron elim for 3-year-old filly pacers, taking on a field that includes Jugette winner **Darena Hanover** and New York Sires Stakes standout **Handsoffmycookie**. Kentucky Filly Futurity winner **Win Missy B** is the 8-5 fave in the Matron elim for 3-year-old filly trotters.

Eleven horses who started on Breeders Crown championship night Oct. 27 at Woodbine Racetrack will line up behind the gate on Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Super Final night on Saturday at that same Toronto racetrack.

Including among the 11 are **Bee A Magician**, who finished third as the beaten favorite in the \$600,000 Two-Year-Old Filly Trot; **Murmur Hanover**, who finished third in the \$600,000 Two-Year-Old Colt Trot; 3-Year-Old Colt Trot starters **Prestidigitator** and **Knows Nothing**, who both also started in the Hambletonian; and Little Brown Jug winner

Michael's Power and Bluegrass winner **Mel Mara**, both starters in the 3-Year-Old Colt Pace.

The first of the eight \$300,000 Super Finals is the second-race contest for first-year filly trotters, with Bee A Magician listed as the 3-5 morning-line choice for driver Rick Zeron, trainer Nifty Norman and owners Mel Hartman, Herb Liverman and David McDuffee.

A winner of more than \$616,000 this year, Bee A Magician had her seven-race win streak snapped in the Breeders Crown final when she finished third after rallying from ninth at the half. Besides a pair of OSS Gold final victories, Bee A Magician also has open-company scores in the Peaceful Way and Champlain.

Prestidigitator romped to an 8 1/4-length victory in last year's Super Final for 2-year-old colt trotters, and he comes back in 2012 to meet nine rivals that includes just two fellow returnees: **Il Mago** (fourth) and **Keystone Orion** (sixth). The son of Kadabra, who finished fourth in the Breeders Crown final, will start from post eight with driver Sylvain Filion.

Knows Nothing will line up in post 10 for Jody Jamieson after a fifth-place finish in the Crown final. While Knows Nothing is a nine-time winner this year, he hasn't reached the winner's circle in four starts after capturing his Canadian Trotting Classic elim in a career-best 1:52.4 Sept. 8 at Mohawk. The Jeff Gillis-trained son of Kadabra earlier won the Canadian Breeders Championship at Mohawk.

Michael's Power was a \$62,500 supplemental Crown entry by owner Jeff Snyder following his Little Brown Jug victory and a narrow second-place finish in an OSS Gold final at Flamboro Downs, but after finishing fourth in his elim he was a non-factor 10th in the final after starting from post 10. Scott Zeron will again drive for trainer Casie Coleman from post three.

Lining up in post two is Mel Mara, who bested Michael's Power by a neck in that OSS Gold final at Flamboro. Mel Mara finished seventh in the Crown final after starting from post 10. Ron Pierce has been named to drive by trainer Tony Alagna. Starting from the inside post is reigning O'Brien Award winner **Warrawee Needy**, who on Sept. 22 blazed to an OSS record 1:48.4 win in a Sept. 22 Gold final at Mohawk. Jody Jamieson drives for his father, trainer and co-owner Carl Jamieson.

Average Price Drops In Harrisburg

Through three sessions, and with approximately 318 yearlings being sold in the final session on Thursday, the Standardbred Horse Sale yearling auction in Harrisburg, Pa., had generated an average price of \$34,247. That's a decline of 4.5 percent from the first three sessions in 2011, when 800 horses were sold for an average of \$35,869.

The third session concluded Wednesday (Nov. 7) with a double-dip percentage drop in the average price. A total of 308 horses were sold in the third session for an average price of \$16,366, down 11.5 percent from an average of \$18,493 in last year's third session, when 275 horses were sold.

This year's opening three sessions resulted in a median price of \$20,500. The median price—the point where half the yearlings sell for more and half for less—was \$20,000 for the entire 2011 Harrisburg sale.

Churchill Hanover, a colt by Well Said from the prolific mare Cathedra, was sold for \$380,000 in Monday's session to top the sale. Bred and consigned by Hanover Shoe Farms, the colt was purchased by Emilio and Maria Rosati's E&M Stride of Australia.

Cathedra is the dam of the million-dollar winning fillies Cathedra Dot Com and Cabrini Hanover along with the top colts Western Shooter and The Preacher Pan. Mark Harder will be training the colt.

A total of four yearlings brought prices of \$300,000 or more in the opening session. In addition to the sale top-per, Myron Bell, who has enjoyed a huge season with the top 2-year-old pacing colt Captaintreacherous, bought Blister Hanover, a colt by Somebeachsomewhere out of a sister to Big Jim, with a bid of \$350,000. The colt sold as hip number 111. Bred and consigned by Hanover Shoe Farms, the April 5 foal is the first offspring of the mare Boldnbrash Hanover p,3, 1:54f, a daughter of The Panderosa-Bold Pink p, 1:51.3.

Just a few hip numbers later, Kevin McDermott bought the Well Said brother to Bettor Sweet and Sweet Lou for \$325,000. Bred by Seth Rosenfeld's Birnam Wood Farms, Concord Stud raised and consigned the colt, who was born on March 2. McDermott was acting as agent for John Cancliere, who owns Bettor Sweet.

Just six horses before the opening session concluded, Odds On Racing bought hip 248, Joost Hanover, a colt by Somebeachsomewhere out of Jasmine Hanover, the dam of Little Miss Dragon and Artstanding, for \$300,000.

Another Somebeachsomewhere colt that commanded a big price in the opening session was hip 85, a colt out of Thong. Chris Oakes bought the colt with a bid of \$295,000. Bred and consigned by Diamond Creek Farm, the colt—a Feb. 11 foal—is the first foal of Thong p,3, 1:50.2 (Western Hanover), who won the Eternal Camnation and Debutante at 2 and Lismore and Tarport Hap at age 3.

A total of 55 horses had been sold for \$100,000 or more in the first three sessions.

Hillbilly Hanover Aims For First Win Of 2012 In Messenger

Prior to the draw for Saturday's \$415,820 Messenger Stakes for 3-year-old pacers at Yonkers Raceway, trainer Ron Burke said he would "love our chances" if his horse Hillbilly Hanover drew an inside post. After getting post one, Burke will get to see if Hillbilly Hanover can take advantage and get his first victory of the season.

Hillbilly Hanover, who joined the Burke Stable on Sept. 30, is winless in 19 starts this year, but has earned \$236,503 thanks in part to a second-place finish to stablemate Sweet Lou in the \$510,300 Tattersalls Pace on Oct. 6 at The Red Mile. Hillbilly Hanover missed winning by a head.

Jim Morrill Jr., who drove Hillbilly Hanover in the Tattersalls, as well as to a sixth-place finish in the Breeders Crown, will be at the lines in the Messenger.

"He's 0-for-the-year for a reason; he doesn't want to win yet," Burke said. "But I think he's very competitive."

Hillbilly Hanover is a son of Dragon Again, out of the mare Hattie. He is a half-brother to Holborn Hanover, who earned \$2 million on the racetrack, and millionaire Hyperion Hanover. Prior to Hillbilly Hanover, 10 of Hattie's 11 foals made it to the races and earned a total of \$4.62 million.

"He's the breed that we like," said Burke, who owns Hillbilly Hanover with Weaver BrusceMI LLC, Frank Baldachino and Larry Karr. "He's a Dragon Again and we seem to do well with them. He's kind of our kind of horse; a little bit on the lazy side, but good gaited, has a lot of talent, just needs maybe to be pushed to get it out of him." (HRC)

Archangel Named New York Horse Of The Year

The most notable personalities of Empire State racing gathered in the grand ballroom at the Vernon Downs Hotel on Sunday, Oct. 28, for the 2012 New York Sires Stakes (NYSS) Awards Banquet and USTA District 8 meetings.

The 3-year-old trotter Archangel (1:53.1; \$906,579; Credit Winner-Michelle's Angel) was named the USTA District 8 sophomore trotter of the year and overall Horse of the Year. Archangel is owned by Alan Hainsworth, Clare Semer and trainer Peter Arrigenna.

Heston Blue Chip (1:48.4; \$1,157,466; American Ideal-Shot To Go Blue Chip) was named the USTA District 8 Three-Year-Old Pacer of the Year. Trained by Linda Toscano, Heston Blue Chip is owned by Ken Jacobs.

The NYSS Breeder of the Year Award in all three tiers of NYSS racing went to Winbak Farm, which had purse earnings in excess of \$2 million for 2012.

Adding to her long list of accomplishments this year, Toscano was named the top trainer among all conditioners competing in the NYSS as well as USTA District 8 Trainer of the Year. The 27 horses she started earned \$1,411,618 in purse money while posting 32 wins, 14 seconds and 17 thirds in 115 starts.

Truman Gale won NYSS County Fair Trainer of the Year. His 12 horses had 79 starts with an impressive 25 wins, 25 seconds and 12 thirds for purse earnings totaling \$47,369 in NYSS action.

Jim Morrill Jr. was once again on top of the driver colony and was presented the award for being NYSS and USTA District 8 driver of the year. Morrill teamed 84 horses to 52 wins, 36 seconds and 25 thirds in 175 starts and \$2,633,647 in purse earnings.

Meadowlands Changes To "ABC Racing"

The Meadowlands will introduce ABC Racing when the track re-opens on Dec. 28. ABC Racing categorizes horses into A, B and C rankings, replacing conditions determined by money earnings. This permits the racing secretary to create races in which the entrants are most competitive and equal in ability.

After a meeting of Meadowlands chairman Jeff Gural, Standardbred Breeders & Owners Association of New Jersey president Tom Luchento and Hall of Fame driver John Campbell, it was agreed to move forward with the new format.

"We think the best racing can be accomplished by classifying horses by their ability and not their money earnings," Luchento said. "The goal is to have full fields and competitive fields. We think ABC Racing will facilitate both objectives."

"We are going to experiment with classified racing (ABC) versus conditioned racing as a way to classify horses," said Meadowlands director of racing and racing secretary Peter Koch. "We are hopeful this method will yield even more competitive racing for our fans. We will still have non-winners of two races lifetime as well as non-winners of three races lifetime for the younger horses and claiming races at every level.

"Classified racing has horses evaluated by the racing secretary and moved up and down in class based upon performance," Koch noted. "We look forward to bringing the public the great racing product the Meadowlands has always had." (*Meadowlands*)

Meadowlands Releases Tentative Series List

The Meadowlands Racetrack would like to advise horsemen of new series and racing opportunities available this winter and spring at the East Rutherford oval.

In addition to the previously released January and February late-closing program and returning regulars, the Meadowlands has tentatively scheduled a new Claiming Survivor Series for starters in a \$15,000 claimer or less in February. Other new events include the All Sires for 3-year-old colt and gelding pacers who have started in any sires stakes race (any state or province) scheduled for April, and the Meadowlands Maturity, a \$100,000 (estimated) event for 4-year-old trotters on May 4. The overwhelmingly popular Rags To Riches for \$10,000 claimers, introduced in 2012, will return in March.

The Meadowlands' 2013 harness meet begins Friday, Dec. 28, 2012, with racing three nights a week, Thursday-Saturday, through March 16. The schedule then reverts to Friday-Saturday until the Championship Meet finale on Hambletonian Day, Aug. 3.

Ontario Panel Says Sires Stakes Purses To Stay Same

The three member panel charged with the transition of horse racing in Ontario issued a statement on Tuesday, Nov. 6, revealing their expectations regarding the purse structure of the Ontario Sires Stakes program. The full statement, issued today in response to a request for clarification from the Standardbred Breeders Association of Ontario (SBOA), is as follows:

"With the implementation of the recommendations by our panel, and with fine tuning of the funding in the weeks

ahead, it is our expectation and intent that the current purse structure for the highly successful OSS program could be maintained for 2013 and beyond."

Anna Meyers, president of the SBOA, sees the written statement as an important step in restoring confidence in Ontario's world renowned breeding sector.

"The SBOA has asked the panel for clarity and they've provided this written response," said Meyers. "At Harrisburg this week, we're hearing a lot of questions from breeders that are selling Ontario-sired horses. We believe it is extremely important that buyers understand that this vital program will continue in its entirety and we hope this will give them confidence as they make buying decisions this week."

While Meyers is pleased with the statement, she cautions that there is still work to be done. "We feel there is a lot of discussion that needs to take place on a number of issues, and we're very hopeful that we're able to make meaningful progress on behalf of the many Standardbred breeders in Ontario."

The panel, which consists of Elmer Buchanen, John Snobelen and John Wilkinson, last month issued their panel report on the future of horse racing in Ontario. (SC)

Chapter Seven To Stand At Blue Chip In New York

Chapter Seven, world champion and winner of the Breeders Crown Open Trot, will stand at Blue Chip Farm of New York for the 2013 breeding season, co-owner Southwind Farm announced.

The 4-year-old stallion, co-owned by Richard Gutnick, Southwind Farm and Jerry and Theresa Silva, and trained by Linda Toscano, will stand at Blue Chip for a fee of \$8,500. The syndicate will be managed by Southwind Farm.

"I've got mixed emotions," said Gutnick, who also owns 2012 Hambletonian winner Market Share. "I really wanted him to race another year, but the fact that I have both Chapter Seven and Market Share made the decision tougher because I don't want them to race against one another."

Chapter Seven will make the final start of his career this Saturday in the American National Open Trot at Balmoral Park. After the race, he will travel to Southwind Farm to begin fertility testing.

"He was all heart," said Gutnick. "It's not just his talent. It was his heart, too. The Breeders Crown really signified his heart. When you are outside the whole mile and keep coming, you can't ask for anything for more than that. I just hope he transfers that to his offspring." (USTA)

Harness Racing Election-Related News

One day after casino expansion in Maryland was approved by voters, Penn National Gaming, which owns Rosecroft Raceway, issued a statement saying it was dis-

appointed in the outcome. Penn National reportedly spent more than \$41 million trying to convince voters to defeat Question 7 on Tuesday's ballot, which allows the state to add table games at the existing slots sites as well as a sixth casino in Prince George's County, where Rosecroft is located, but not at the track itself.

Penn National's statement noted that the company had "spent a lot of time, energy and resources to educate voters on the flaws of Issue 7," and that the state should have allowed Rosecroft to be considered for the site of the casino.

The new Prince George's County casino cannot open until 2016. Table games can now begin early next year as well as when a new casino opens in Baltimore City.

The Baltimore Sun reported that Question 7 prompted the most spending ever for a campaign in Maryland. A story it published Wednesday (Nov. 7) said, "MGM, hoping to become the operator of a glittering \$800 million "destination resort" casino at National Harbor in Prince George's County, urged voters to clear the way for its plans by approving Question 7. Penn National, seeing National Harbor as a threat to its flagship casino in Charles Town, W.Va., matched MGM nearly dollar for dollar in its bid to defeat the measure.

"While the cost of the campaign was enormous—more than double Maryland's most expensive gubernatorial race—the stakes for the two companies were many times greater. Gambling industry experts said that over the long term, a National Harbor casino could cost Penn National hundreds of millions of dollars while MGM could earn billions at National Harbor."

In Florida, voters approved slots at pari-mutuel operations in Palm Beach County, which means the Rooney family, which owns Palm Beach Kennel Club, can put them in and compete with the Isle Pompano Park, which has been the closest gaming for residents of the county. Also in Florida, Dan Daley, the son of Dan and Ann-Marie Daley, won Coral Springs city council Seat 2 by a margin of 56.6-43.4 percent.

Purse Increase At Rosecroft

Rosecroft Raceway announced on Tuesday, Nov. 6, a roughly 10 percent increase to purses will begin on Saturday night, Nov. 10. All classes, except the winners-over, will have at least a 10 percent increase.

"We are happy to be able to reward the horsemen that have made this meet a success so far and look to build on that success with this increase," said racing secretary Michael Wandishin.

In other news, Rosecroft will make up the "lost card" of Oct. 27 on Thursday, Dec. 20, pending approval by the Maryland Racing Commission. Post time will be 7:25 pm. This will enable horsemen to race twice in the final eight calendar days of the meet. (Rosecroft)

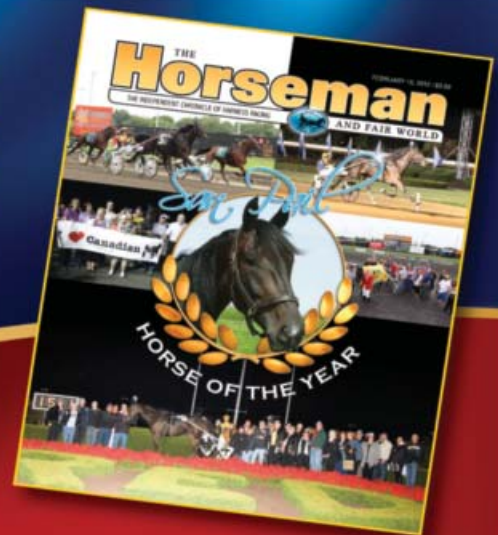
